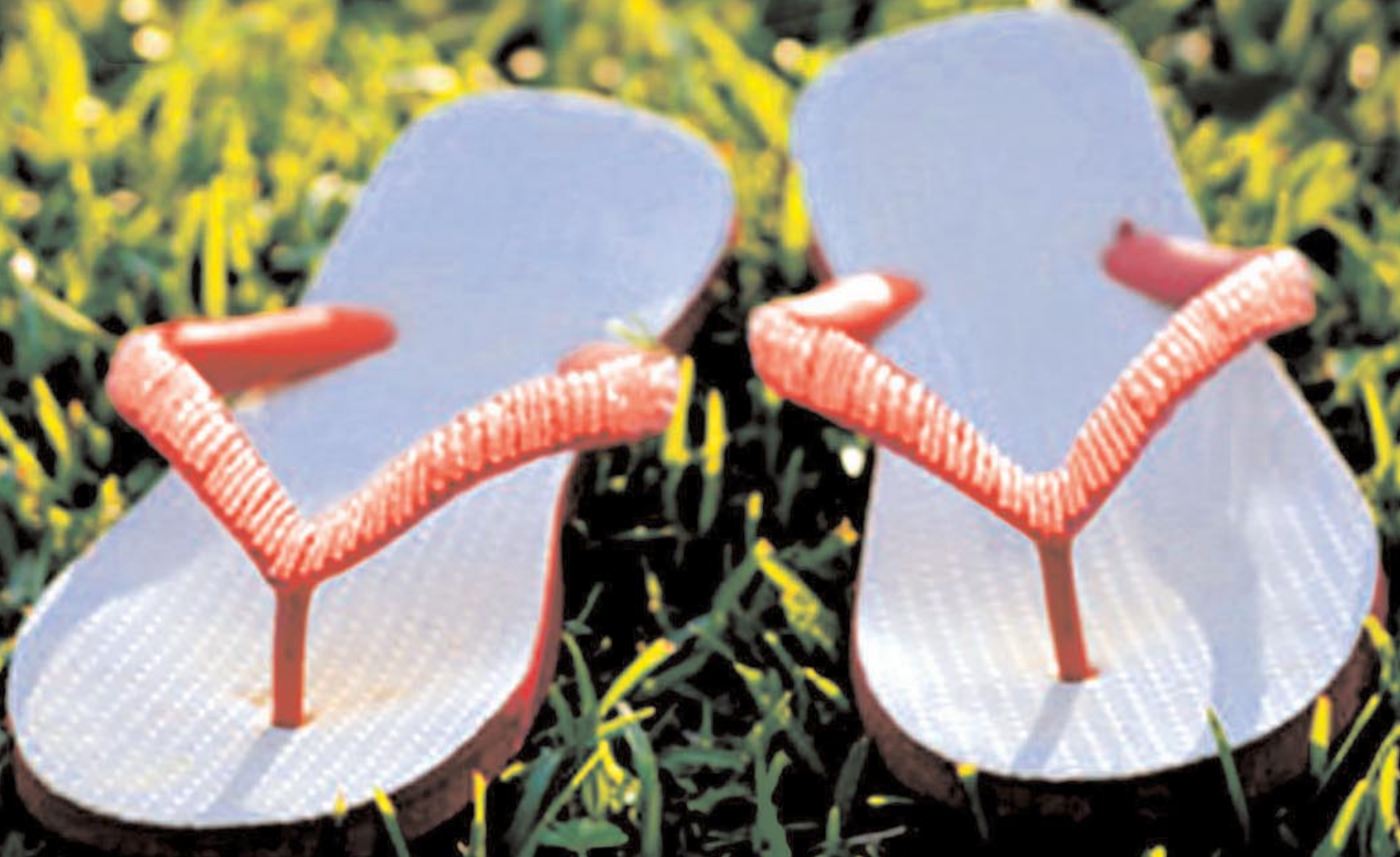

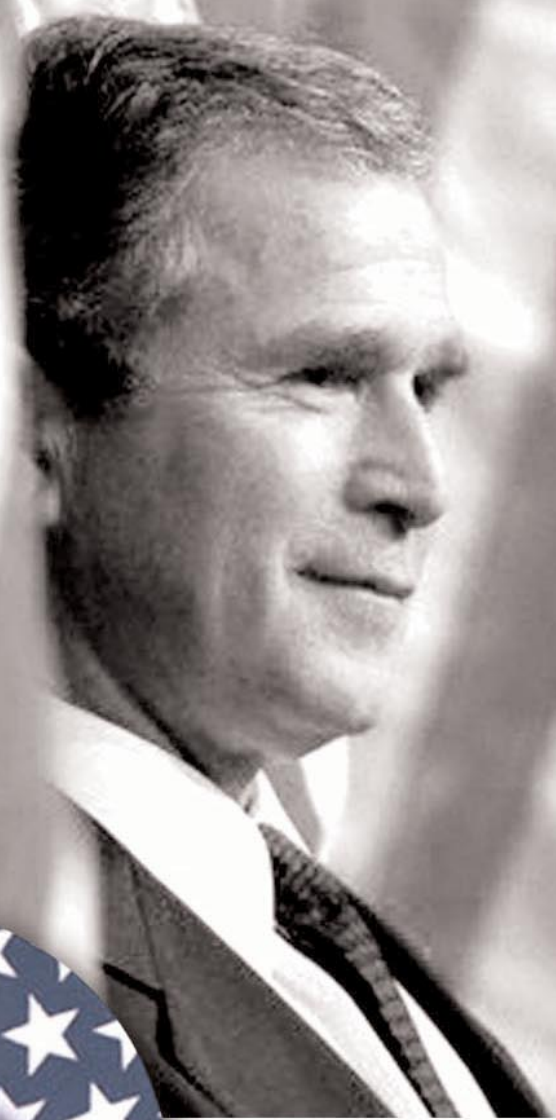

Mr. Bush initially opposed creating a new Department of Homeland Security.

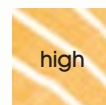
Mr. Bush reversed himself and backed the largest expansion of the federal government since 1949.

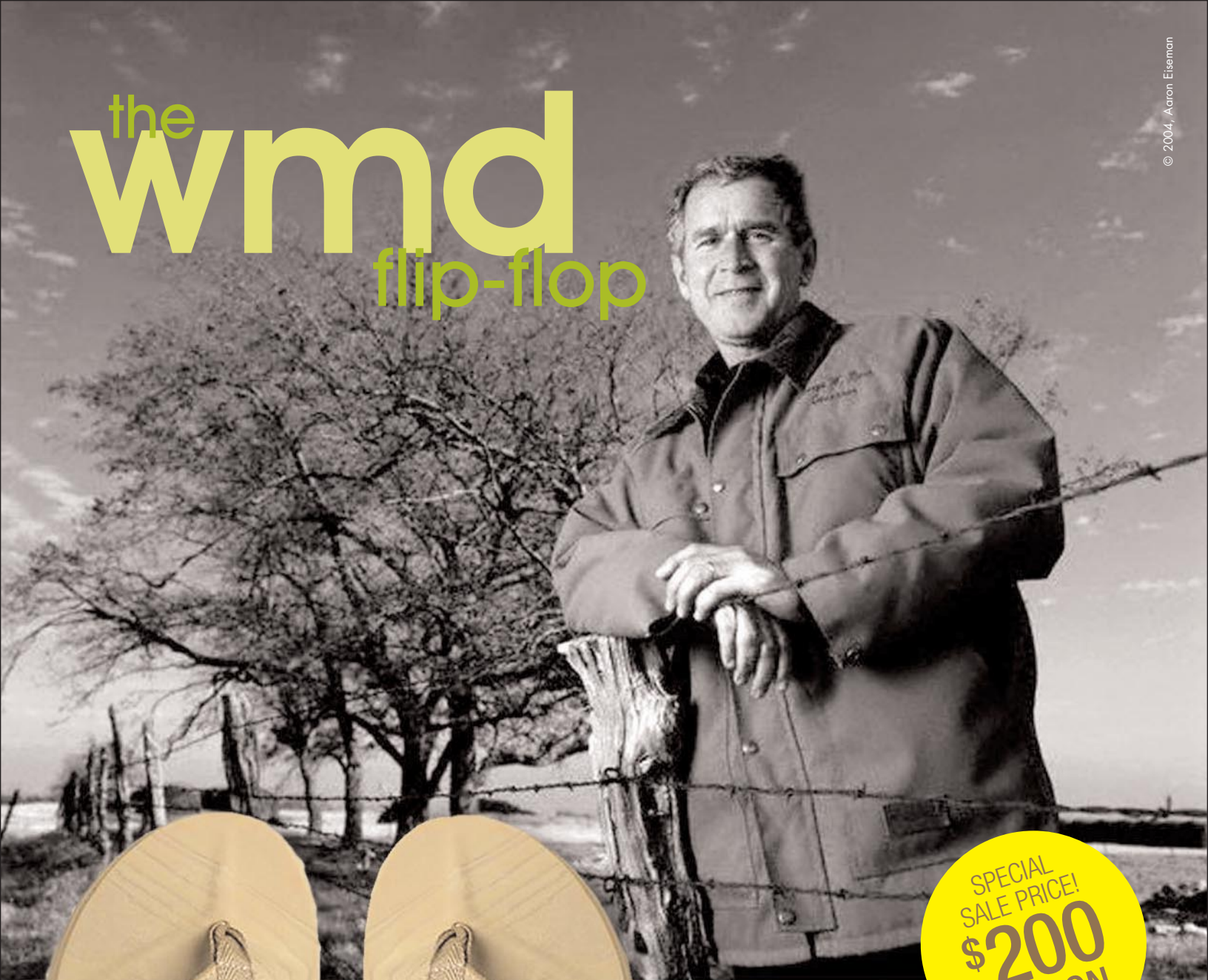

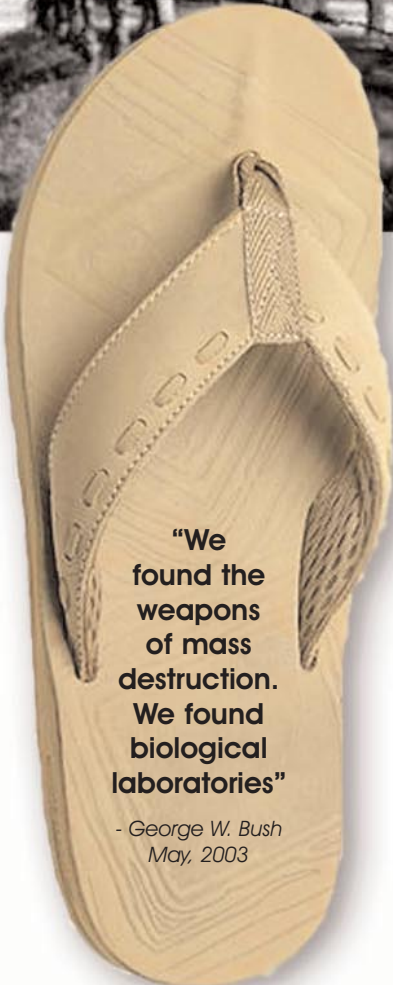

## step on the constitution in style.

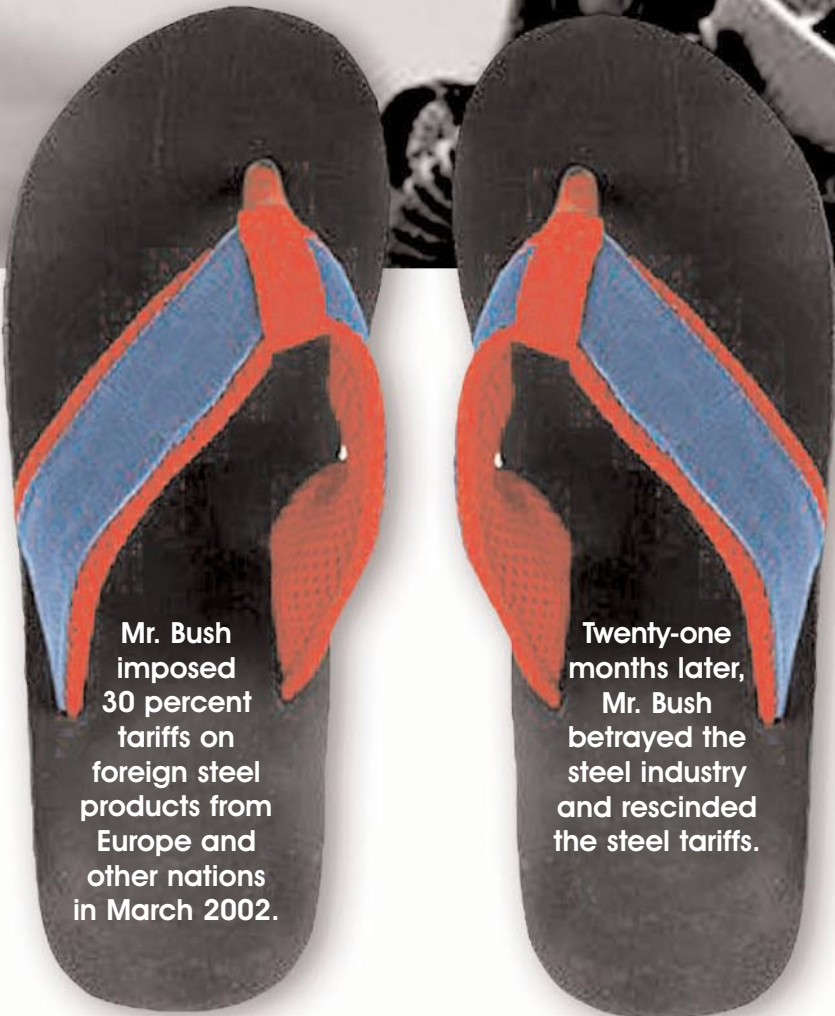
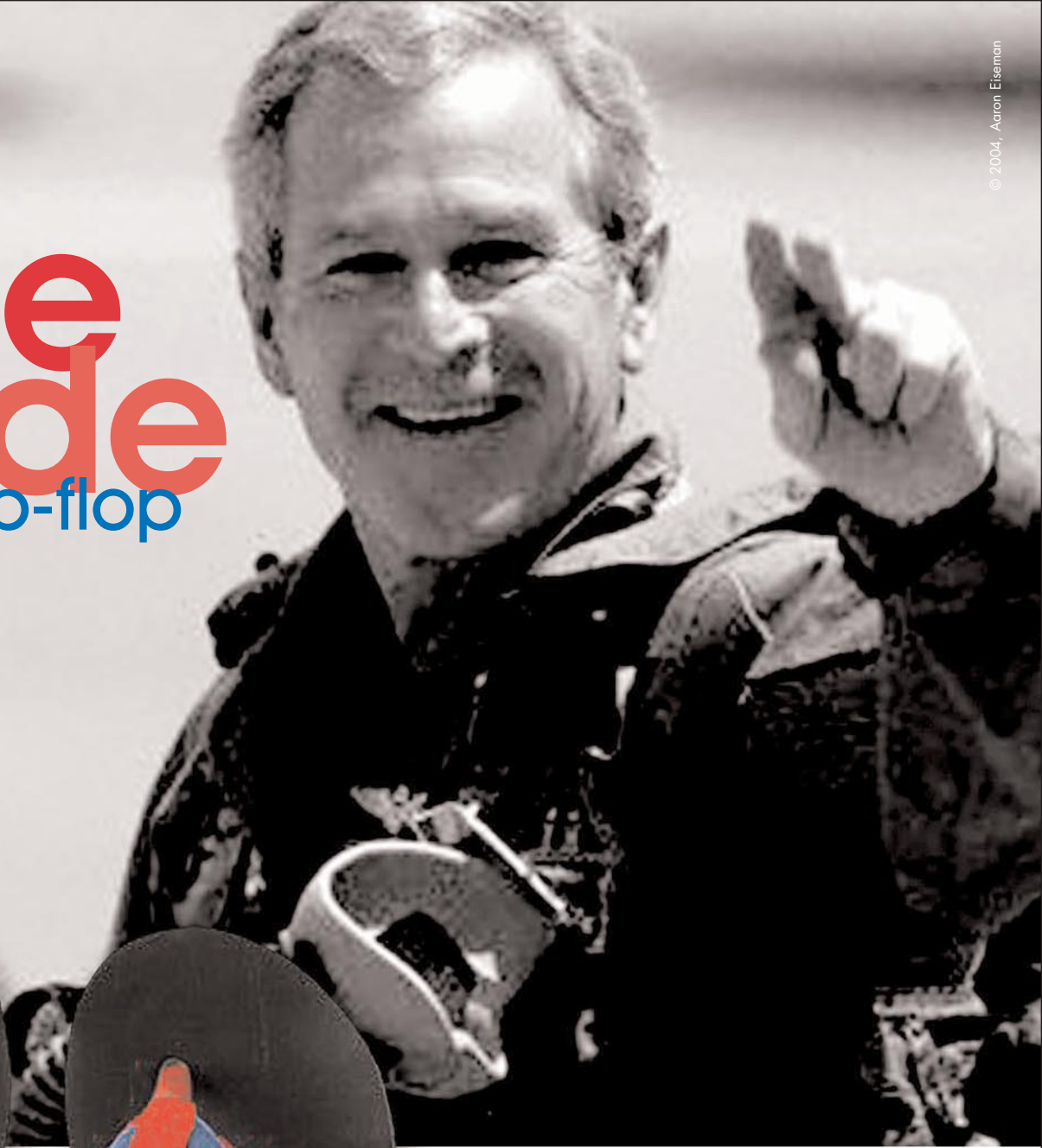
